Pre-Surgery Factsheet

Below you will find answers to some common questions about your pet's pre-surgery care. We also welcome your calls before surgery or anytime. Please call our office if you have any questions or concerns at (989)723-1681.

The night before the surgery:

- 1. No food after 10pm please remove all opportunities even if there are other pets in the same household.
- 2. It is OK for water to be available until your departure to the animal hospital.
- 3. Keep your indoor/outdoor cats in the house.
- 4. SAVE TIME by printing out and completing our <u>Surgery Authorization Form</u> online at <u>www.northsidevet.net</u>

Bringing your pet to the hospital:

- 1. On the morning of your pet's surgery, please arrive between 8:30 and 9am.
- 2. If needed, you may bring your pet to the hospital the evening before surgery.
- 3. When entering the hospital, please use a leash or pet carrier to protect your pet.

If your pet is diabetic:

- 1. Do not feed in the morning.
- 2. Allow free access to water.
- 3. Give $\frac{1}{2}$ the regular dose of insulin.
- 4. Upon check-in inform the hospital staff the time that the insulin was given.

If your pet is taking a prescribed oral medication:

- 1. Give the medication as early as possible in the morning.
- 2. If you need to give the medication in or with food- use the minimum amount possible.
- 3. Upon check-in, inform the hospital staff the time that the medication was given.
